Based on your response during our telephone conversation on 2/6/2009 and amendment request dated 2/9/09 (copy attached), the option checked below applies to your request regarding use of licensed material under an NRC license:

- You have reviewed your current license and have determined that you need to maintain both an NRC license and a Commonwealth of Virginia license. You therefore request that your existing NRC license be amended to remove authorization for use of material in the Commonwealth of Virginia and authorize work activities only in non-Agreement States. In addition, you request that the NRC issue a new license for work activities only in the Commonwealth of Virginia. You understand that your new license will then be transferred to the Commonwealth of Virginia in conjunction with the effective date of the Agreement between the NRC and the Commonwealth of Virginia. You further understand that you will be assessed annual fees to maintain both the NRC and Commonwealth of Virginia licenses.
- You have reviewed your current license and no longer find it necessary for authorization to conduct licensed activities in Virginia, and therefore request that your existing NRC license be amended to authorize the use of material only in West Virginia and where NRC maintains jurisdiction. AMENDMENT REQUEST dated 2/9/09 rec'd.

Additional comments:	Based on our conversation today (2/6/09), Mr. Perkins indicated that they used portable gauges owned by the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) when performing licensed activities in the Commonwealth of Virginia. Mr. Perkins indicated that they did not transport their portable gauges to Virginia. The company only sent employees down there to use VDOT gauges and that work was probably less than 180 calendar days. Mr. Perkins indicated that the facility located at 10800 Midlothian Turnpike, Richmond, VA does not store any of their gauges

Dear Ms. Modes:

In accordance with our conversation and based on the fact that Virginia will become an Agreement State effective April 1, 2009, Greenhorne & O'Mara (G&O) requests that our NRC License be amended to include West Virginia only.

G&O's usage of nuclear gauges in Virginia remains out of our Richmond office at 10900 Midlothian Turnpike, Suite 310, Richmond, Virginia 23235. Usage of these nuclear gauges will not exceed 180 days in a calendar year. No gauges will be stored at our Richmond, Virginia office and all employees using the gauges will be from our Richmond office. In the past all gauges being used were owned by VDOT (Virginia Department of Transportation). We therefore request that all nuclear gauge usage in Virginia be under reciprocity using G&O's Maryland's "Agreement State" license.
