## NRC Affected Procedures

- 12 potentially affected procedures
  - Reactive inspection procedures
  - Event follow-up procedures
  - Plant status procedure
  - Baseline inspection procedures

## **NRC Affected Procedures (cont'd)**

- 2 new proposed procedures
  - 1 new inspection procedure
    - Detailed inspection guidance to evaluate selected aspects of Subpart I
  - 1 Temporary Instruction (TI)
    - Verify procedures and processes are in place to implement Subpart I requirements
    - Applicable to licensees and other entities subject to Subpart I



## Proposed Development Priority

- Revise plant status/outage procedures
  - IMC 2515, Appendix D / IP 71111.20
- Develop new inspection procedure
- Provide reference to new procedure in all other procedures
- Develop TI

# Issue Draft Procedures

- Provide new procedure and changes to plant status to Regions for review and comment
- Provide draft TI to Regions for comment



# Issue Final Procedures

- Scheduled to be issued by August 31, 2009
- Allows for inspectors/licensees to become familiar with final documents
- Allows time to train inspectors on new inspection guidance

## Temporary Instruction

- Primary focus will be to verify procedures and processes in place to implement Subpart I requirements
- Performed within 12 months of implementation date
- Information evaluated to update new and revised procedures
