In accordance with 10 *Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR) 70.34, and 95.19, USEC Inc. (USEC) hereby submits a request for amendment to the Materials License for the American Centrifuge Lead Cascade Facility. This license amendment request revises the Security Program, Chapter 2, "Security Plan for the Protection of Classified Matter." This change was determined to be a substantive change in accordance with 10 CFR 95.19 and requires NRC prior review and approval.

Enclosure 1 to this letter provides a detailed description, justification for the proposed change, and USEC's determination that the proposed change associated with this license amendment request is not significant. 
