Summary of Management Actions and Statistical Analysis for Reporting Period

Summary of Management Actions and Statistical Analysis for Reporting Period - July2008 - December 2008

Analysis of the data indicates that we randomly tested 26.9% of the average eligible population during the period of this report. Overall, we tested 56% of the average population for calendar year 2008.

Due to an influx of support personnel in support of a refueling outage during this reporting period, we had a total of eight positive drug tests, all of which were short term contractor employees. There were no reportable events associated with the testing and no events were reported by telephone in accordance with 10CFR26 or 10CFR73.

In addition, Luminant Power submitted blind performance specimens in accordance with 10CFR26, Appendix A, Section 2.8(e)(2), requirements. There were no reportable events associated with the performance specimen testing.
