

North Anna Unit 3 Combined License Application (COLA) Reviewer's Aid

User Instructions

Purpose

Dominion submitted a revision to the North Anna Unit 3 Combined License Application (COLA) by letter dated December 12, 2008. The purpose of the Reviewer's Aid (RA) is to provide additional information about COLA changes, beyond that presented in the COLA revision summary table included as part of the formal COLA revision. The RA also serves to link the additional information to specific changes in the COLA as an aid for COLA reviewers.

The information in the RA does not change or supersede information contained in the formal COLA revision. In the event of a discrepancy between the COLA revision and the RA, the formal COLA revision is controlling.

Description

The RA consists of these instructions, an annotated version of the non-proprietary COLA, and a Change Summary Table.

The Annotated COLA is divided into five text-searchable portable document format (pdf) files, with bookmarks included for navigation purposes. The Annotated COLA has hand-written "Change Identifiers" noted in the margin next to each revision bar. The Change Identifiers serve as a reference to the applicable information in the Change Summary Table.

The Change Summary Table is a text-searchable pdf file, sorted alpha-numerically by Change Identifier, which provides a description and basis for each COLA change.

Instructions

1. Open the Annotated COLA file that includes the Part/Section of interest. The file titles reflect the Part/Sections included.
2. Locate a COLA change of interest in the Annotated COLA file and note the Change Identifier adjacent to the revision bar.
3. Open the file titled, "002 Change Summary Table."
4. Locate the Change Identifier in the Change Summary Table that corresponds to the COLA change of interest to review the description and basis for the change.

Editorial Changes

During the COLA revision process, editorial changes were implemented as a process efficiency. Editorial changes are annotated and appear in the Change Summary Table. However, individual descriptions and the basis for each editorial change are not included because editorial changes were limited to:

- Clear and obvious punctuation errors
- Clear and obvious spelling errors
- Grammatical changes that did not affect the intent of the sentence, e.g., changing “million of dollars” to “millions of dollars”
- Updating COLA section titles and paragraph numbering to be consistent and aligned with corresponding title and paragraph numbering changes made in DCD Revision 5
- Revisions to COLA statements to be consistent when specifying where supplemental information was to be inserted in a COLA section as it related to DCD text. Changes in DCD format from Rev. 4 to Rev. 5, such as changing the number of paragraphs in a section, drove the need to revise these instructions. For example, if DCD Rev. 5 inserted a new paragraph at the beginning of a section, the COLA instruction “Insert the following sentence after the first paragraph” became “Insert the following sentence after the second paragraph.”
- Non-technical wording changes to improve readability (e.g., replacing “Section 3.9.6, Section 5.2.4, and Section 6.6” with “Sections 3.9.6, 5.2.4, and 6.6.”)
- Clarification of acronyms (e.g., spelling out the first appearance of an acronym, correcting transposed acronyms)

Exceptions

Certain information in the COLA was not annotated: Tables of Contents, Lists of Tables, and Lists of Figures. Also, the Annotated COLA only includes the front pages of the Technical Specifications and the Evacuation Time Estimate, with the identification of the associated Change Identifier(s) that affected these documents. Annotation of each revision bar of these documents was deemed unnecessary due to the repetitive nature of the changes, resulting from the same Change Identifier(s).
