Summary of Management Actions Taken and List of Fitness For Duty Event Reports Page 1 of 1

From July 1, 2008, through December 31, 2008, the Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station (DBNPS) Fitness for Duty (FFD) records indicate the following results:

Licensee Employees

For licensee employees, one individual tested positive for alcohol in the follow-up category. All other categories results in no confirmed positives.

Follow-up Category:

One licensee individual tested positive for alcohol while enrolled in the follow-up program. This individual was originally in the follow-up program due to a non Part 26 violation. The individual was denied unescorted access and is currently in an Employee Assistance Program (EAP) and complying with a recommended treatment. It is anticipated the individual will initiate the process for unescorted access in the near future.

Short-Term Contractors

For short-term contractors, one individual was confirmed positive for a single substance. This individual was denied due to the attempt to subvert the drug screening process and for testing positive for marijuana.

For-Cause/Subversion:

One short-term contractor was tested under the pre-access category; however the collected specimen was not within temperature range. Prior to the observed collection, a search was conducted on the individual and a small bottle was found on the person. Individual admitted to using an adulterant. The observed specimen resulted in a confirmed positive for marijuana. This individual was denied unescorted access for a minimum of three years due to the attempt to subvert the drug screening process and for the confirmed positive result for marijuana.

List of Events Reported

No Fitness-For-Duty events were reported under the provisions of 10 CFR 26.73 by the DBNPS during this reporting period (July – December 2008).
