3. Spoke with John Halsey, at the Michigan SHPO's office. He suggested I review the MACRPA website and call Willie Johnson of the **Saginaw Chippewa Indian Tribe of Michigan. A (3) indicated the tribe is listed on the MACRPA website. Note that some non-Federally recognized Tribes are on the MACRPA website, but I did not include them on this list.**
