Dear Mr. Barker:

Attached are the comprehensively revised Radiological Incident Response Plan (Version 2.0) for the Wisconsin Department of Health Services (dated January 30, 2009), and page revisions for the Emergency Operations Plans (EOPs) for the Wisconsin counties of Kewaunee (dated March, 2009), Manitowoc (dated February, 2009) and Pierce (dated February, 2009). Kewaunee and Manitowoc Counties lie within the 10-mile emergency planning zones for the Kewaunee Power Station and Point Beach Nuclear Power Plant. Pierce County lies within the 10-mile emergency planning zone for the Prairie Island Nuclear Generating Plant.

Also included are copies of the following public information materials: “Manitowoc County • Kewaunee County 2009 Nuclear Emergency Planning Information Calendar;” “A Message to Visitors in Our Community;” and “Radiological Emergency Information for Wisconsin Farmers, Food Processors and Distributors Near the Nuclear Power Plants in and Surrounding the State of Wisconsin.”

We request that you review this material for conformity to Title 44, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 350, and the requirements in NUREG-0654. Specifically, we request that you review the Wisconsin Department of Health Services “Nuclear Incident Response Plan” (Version 2.0) for technical content. Please provide written comments regarding your review to FEMA, Region V, by April 3, 2009. Please retain the prior approved plan sections until all Regional Assistance Committee members have provided us with their review comments. At that time we will notify you of our findings concerning final approval, and provide updating instructions.
