RE: Comments on North Anna Unit 3 Draft Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement


Dear Ms. Williamson:

The public forum last evening was excellent. I did not present any thoughts last night so will do so as follows.

My entire career has been in energy exploration and environmental work in the private sector. My formal education has been in geology. I am very supportive of nuclear energy and for the NRC to issue a combined license for the North Anna Power Station, Unit 3, based upon the draft SEIS. This country made a decision to use nuclear power some 30 years ago and we have only seen positive upgrades to existing systems. Now we have an opportunity to finally invest in an additional reactor.

Lake Anna has been a benefit to the region for surface water storage, recreation, conservation and wildlife. Water quality, water flow, water temperature variations, drought effects, and wetlands as well as possible impacts on wildlife have been addressed. Also, businesses and residential properties will continue to improve and benefit the county and state for generations into the future. Our need for electricity has increased due to population growth and additional electrically generated technologies. Conservation of electricity has been an ongoing goal for decades but the status quo can not continue. Lessons learned from past reactor issues have insured that the most reliable technologies will be in place for the proposed Unit 3.
