EPRI MCC-Based Motor Torque Periodic Verification Methodology (1015069)

- Proposed review schedule
 - NRC review and Safety Evaluation Issuance is requested within 2 years

EPRI MCC-Based Motor Torque Periodic Verification Methodology (1015069)

- On-going regulatory and industry efforts
 - NRC inspections and compliance monitoring of licensees' implementation of commitments on GL 89-10 and GL 96-05.
 - Adoption of JOG Program into licensees' GL 96-05 efforts; some plants have expressed intent to use MCC testing
 - NRC review and approval of Mandatory Appendix III to ASME ISTC "Preservice and Inservice Testing of Active Electric Motor-Operated Valve Assemblies in LWR Power Plants"
 - Section III-6100 states; "Motor control center testing is acceptable if correlation with testing at the MOV has been established."

EPRI MCC-Based Motor Torque Periodic Verification Methodology (1015069)

- Fee Waiver Basis
 - Per 170.11 Exemptions, No special project fees shall be required for:
 - (1)(iii) Reports submitted as a means of exchanging information between industry organizations and the NRC specifically for the purpose of supporting NRC's generic regulatory improvements or efforts.
 - (1)(iii)(A) NRC review of 1015069 supports ongoing NRC regulatory efforts as described on the preceding slide.
 - (1)(iii)(B) NRC is the primary beneficiary of NRC's review and approval because this action facilitates consistent implementation of NRC regulations and reduces staff resources for inspections and compliance monitoring (compared to NRC reviewing multiple plant-unique approaches).

EPRI MOV PPM Code Version 3.4

- Proposed review schedule
 - NRC review and Safety Evaluation Issuance is requested within 1 year
 - Minor changes from last approved Code Version
 - Review time required should be minimal

EPRI MOV PPM Code Version 3.4

- Ongoing regulatory and industry efforts
 - PPM code originally approved by SE in 1996 and provides methods for complying with GL 89-10
 - As requested by NRC in the 1996 SE, EPRI continues to assess implementation and make improvements
 - Subsequent NRC reviews have supported SE supplements on later Code versions through Version 3.3
 - PPM has been widely adopted by licensees; NRC reviews and inspects these activities.
 - NRC approval facilitates consistent implementation by licensees
 - PPM Code revisions expected in the future as additional information becomes available or corrections are needed
 - NRC review and approval of Mandatory Appendix III to ASME ISTC

EPRI MOV PPM Code Version 3.4

- Fee Waiver Basis
 - Per 170.11 Exemptions, No special project fees shall be required for:
 - (1)(iii) Reports submitted as a means of exchanging information between industry organizations and the NRC specifically for the purpose of supporting NRC's generic regulatory improvements or efforts.
 - (1)(iii)(A) NRC review of 1018298 supports ongoing NRC regulatory efforts as described on the preceding slide.
 - (1)(iii)(B) NRC is the primary beneficiary of NRC's review and approval because this action facilitates consistent implementation of NRC regulations and provides an efficient way for NRC to confirm that EPRI is fulfilling NRC's request (to assess industry information) in the 1996 SE.
