
Dear Sir or Madam:

Indiana Heart Associates P.C. would like to amend its NRC Byproduct Materials License, Number 13-24834-01 to request a transfer of control of its licensed activities. Specifically, Indiana Heart Associates, P.C.'s assets are being purchased by The Indiana Heart Hospital, effective January 1, 2009. In accordance with NRC NUREG 1556, Volume 15, the following information concerning this transfer of control is provided:

1. The transition will result in a purchase of Indiana Heart Associates, PC's assets. The new entity will operate under Indiana Heart Hospital name. 2. The Radiation Safety Officer and Authorized Users will remain the same, as listed on the Indiana Heart Associates, P.C. U.S.N.R.C. license. The officers of the corporation will be as follows Tom Malasto, CEO (new member), Tony Javorka COO (current), Mary Gamache CFO (new) and Ramarao Yeleti MD President (current). The radiation safety officer is currently and will remain Kiran Kareti, MD.
3. The facilities, equipment, technicians and procedures will remain unchanged in the change of ownership.
4. The surveillance program is currently and documented. All records are kept at the addresses of use. The surveillance program will continue to be up to date at the time of the transfer of control.
5. Indiana Heart Associates, P.C. confirms that all records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the facility, pursuant to 10 CFR 30.35(g), 40.36(f), 70.25(g), and 72.30(d); public dose; and waste disposal by release to sewers, incineration, radioactive material spills, and on-site burials, will be transferred to the new licensee, as licensed activities will continue at the same location.
6. The transferee commits to abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, representation, and commitments identified in the existing license.
