Pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, the Energy Reorganization Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-438), and Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter I, Parts 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 39, 40, and 70, and in reliance on statements and representations heretofore made by the licensee, a license is hereby issued authorizing the licensee to receive, acquire, possess, and transfer byproduct, source, and special nuclear material designated below; to use such material for the purpose(s) and at the place(s) designated below; to deliver or transfer such material to persons authorized to receive it in accordance with the regulations of the applicable Part(s). 10. This license does not authorize possession or use of licensed material.
11. The licensee is authorized to distribute only from its facilities located at Genesis Services, 200 Glenn Drive, Gloucester Township, Blackwood, New Jersey and SLi/Midwest, 221 S. Franklin Road #C, Indianapolis, Indiana.
12. The licensee shall submit periodic reports as specified in Section 32.16, 10 CFR Part 32.

Notwithstanding the labeling requirements of Section 32.15(d), Part 32 as it applies to individual lamps, the licensee shall label each immediate lamp container in accordance with 10 CFR 32.15(d) and as described in the licensee's application dated September 22, 2008, and email dated February 25, 2009.
