Purpose: For TVA to provide information to the staff regarding its schedule for completing the reanalysis of the dam breach and probable maximum flood for the Bellefonte 3 and 4 combined license application

Outcome: NRC has a clear understanding of TVA's schedule so that an NRC schedule for the review can be developed

Background: In an October 29, 2008, letter (ADAMS accession number ML082810431) the NRC informed TVA that it was placing a hold on its review of section 2.4 of the Bellefonte units 3 and 4 combined license application and that the review would not restart until:

- a. TVA has met the conditions outlined in a TVA letter dated October 22, 2008 (ADAMS accession number ML082980029).
- b. The NRC staff has conducted a quality assurance review of TVA's completed work to verify through inspection that the probable maximum flood (PMF) and dam breach reanalysis meets 10 CFR 50 Appendix B quality assurance requirements.
