# MEMORANDUM AND ORDER (Additional Mandatory Hearing Matters)

Relative to the mandatory hearing to be convened on March 23, 2009, in Waynesboro, Georgia, pursuant to the Licensing Board's December 31, 2008 issuance, see Licensing Board Memorandum and Order (Additional Presentation Topic and Administrative Directives for Mandatory Hearing) (Dec. 31, 2008) at 6 (unpublished), the order of opening statements will be NRC staff counsel, followed by counsel for applicant Southern Nuclear Operating Company (SNC).

As part of their opening statements, the Board requests that both counsel address the question of the relationship between the findings the Board has been directed to make pursuant to the notice of hearing for this early site permit proceeding, see [SNC]; Notice of Hearing and

Opportunity to Petition for Leave to Intervene on An Early Site Permit for the Vogtle ESP Site, 71 Fed. Reg. 60,195, 60,195 (Oct. 12, 2006), and those required by 10 C.F.R. § 52.24.

Finally, we wish to advise the staff and SNC that, as a general rule, cross-examination of the other party's witnesses by counsel will not be permitted.
