Re: SCANA/Santee Cooper Combined License Application

Dear Nuclear Regulatory Commission:

On behalf of the South Carolina Chamber of Commerce, I am writing to state our support for the two new proposed nuclear reactors in Fairfield County. It is our understanding that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is taking written comments on the scoping process until March 8th. We wish to go on record supporting the construction of the nuclear plants and express our belief that the environment will be well protected during the construction and operation of the nuclear plants.

The operators of the existing nuclear plant in Fairfield County, SCANA and Santee Cooper, have a proven record of running the VC Summer Plant in an environmentally sensitive fashion. With no compelling identifiable negative issues concerning the construction and operation of the new nuclear plants, we look forward to a thorough but efficient review of the combined license application by the NRC.
