Upon consideration of the March 12, 2009 joint motion of applicant Southern Nuclear Operating Co. (SNC), the NRC staff (Staff), and Joint Intervenors¹ to suspend any obligations of the parties relating to (1) mandatory disclosures under 10 C.F.R. § 2.336; (2) the Staff's need to designate its role in the proceeding under 10 C.F.R. § 2.1202(b)(2); (3) the compilation of a hearing file under 10 C.F.R. § 2.1203; and (4) any of the requirements set forth in the Licensing Board's March 5, 2009 memorandum and order granting Joint Intervenors hearing petition and admitting contention SAFETY-1, Low-Level Radioactive Waste Storage, see LBP-09-03, 69 NRC \_ (Mar. 5, 2008), it is

ORDERED, that the parties' March 12, 2009 motion to suspend this proceeding is granted in that this proceeding will be held in abeyance and the dates for actions following the grant of Joint Intervenors hearing petition specified in the agency's regulations and the Board's memorandum and order shall not begin to accrue until <u>fourteen days</u> after (1) in the absence of any appeal from the Board's March 5, 2009 issuance, the date upon which an appeal from the Board's March 5 memorandum and order is due in accord with 10 C.F.R. § 2.311; or (2) in the event a timely appeal from the Board's March 5, 2009 ruling is filed, the date upon which the Commission issues a decision ruling on all appeals from the Board's March 5 decision.
