SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF FEBRUARY 25, 2009, MEETING WITH THE U.S.  
DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY ON YUCCA MOUNTAIN LICENSE

On February 25, 2009, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff hosted a Category 1 public meeting with the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE, the applicant) in Rockville, Maryland. The meeting was videoteleconferenced to the NRC Las Vegas Hearing Facility in Las Vegas, Nevada, and the Center for Nuclear Waste Regulatory Analyses in San Antonio, Texas. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss updates to the DOE's license application (ML090700817) submitted on February 19, 2009. The meeting was open to the public.
