Problem: The implementation of the proposed new NRC rules on working hours for nuclear personnel raises a few concerns. 1) Requirement for a break of at least 48 hours every 14 days current rules are satisfactory. 2) Requirement of a break of at least 24 hours every 7 days. The 10 hour break rule is sufficient.

As mandated by the 1974 Privacy Act, I authorize Senator Kit Bond and his staff to make inquiries on my behalf and to obtain information from my personal records or files.

Rule # 2 Reduction of the outage time that can be excluded from the group work hours from 120 days to 56 days. Time pressure is an event Percussor.
