Purpose: Discuss lessons learned from STP scoping meeting and agree on key actions, formats, protocols for future scoping meetings.

1. Slides

a. Need to agree on content of Scoping Meeting slides: STP's versus Vogtle format or a hybrid of the two. We need to put the "approved boilerplate slides" on the G drive for future use.

b. Although the meeting is to gather scoping comments, it is important to discuss the safety review and hearing process briefly.

c. We should also include a brief discussion in lay terms what our EIS process includes and what our findings may be? We should describe in lay terms what our regulations and NEPA require, do, provide (Alternative is to have a info sheet on the EIS process)

2. Presenters

Should there only be one speaker, e.g. BC or should we maintain a set of three speakers: overview, safety, and scoping topics? We need to decide and make this the standard for future meetings.

3. Protocols:

a. Can we consider only doing one long meeting 6-10 p.m. versus the two meetings?

b. We should use a less formal setup for the speakers: e.g. table at floor level with a small podium at the table for the speaker. Use the travelling mike to gather all public comments and questions.

c. We should conduct a full dry run before each new scoping meeting to run through all speeches, then have practice questions asked of the presenters using q's from STP and other question databases?

d. We need to obtain a commitment from the Regional Offices to send one person to each of the scoping public meetings.

e. Take advantage of Q&A database in EARRTH

f. Expand the selection of NRC brochures provided at the meetings to address transportation, Yucca MT , hearing process, etc.

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
