Please find enclosed License No. 40-29283-02. **The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and the State of Virginia have signed an agreement in which the NRC relinquished its regulatory authority for certain licenses of byproduct, source, and special nuclear material, and in turn the State of Virginia assumes such regulatory authority. This agreement becomes effective on March 31, 2009. This new license allows Digirad Imaging Solutions to continue to use licensed material in the State of Virginia under the new agreement.
