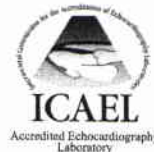

We are requesting concurrent processing of a new NRC materials license for Premier Cardiovascular Specialists and a transfer of a location of use amendment from Michigan Cardiology, P.C. NRC license # 21-32468-01 to Premier Cardiovascular Specialists. www.michigancardiology.net In the interest of continued patient care it is hoped that the issuing of our new license will coincide with the removal of this address of use from Michigan Cardiology, P.C. NRC license. Please find the enclosed information pertaining to both transactions enclosed.

After the approval of Premier Cardiovascular Specialists NRC materials license Michigan Cardiology, P.C. NRC license # 21-32468-01, will sell one of its addresses of use to Premier Cardiovascular Specialists. Michigan Cardiology, P.C. request the deletion of the following location of use, 15120 Michigan Avenue, Suite A, Dearborn, Michigan. Additionally, Michigan Cardiology, P.C. will delete Samer Salka, M.D. from its NRC materials license.

1. Premier Cardiovascular Specialists will obtain possession of the nuclear medicine camera, all radiation safety equipment and all sealed sources at the location listed on Michigan Cardiology, P.C. NRC materials license.
2. All required records regarding the use and possession of licensed materials will be current at the time of the transfer. The status of compliance will be maintained before, during and after the sell.
3. All required documents and records are currently kept in accordance with the NRC license condition. These include, but are not limited to the annual calibration of survey instruments, semi-annual leak testing of non-exempt sealed radioactive sources, radiation monitoring and personnel exposure monitoring reports. Radiation monitoring is performed as required by the NRC licensee on a daily basis for acceptable radiation levels and weekly for removable contamination.



4. We confirm the areas of storage, preparation, handling, and administration of radioactive materials are surveyed daily for acceptable radiation levels and weekly for removable contamination. If contamination of these areas is detected during these daily or weekly surveys, decontamination is undertaken and completed at that time. The unsealed radionuclides in use at this location are all short-lived (i.e. half lives less than 65 days, most less than 10 days). Therefore, radioactive contamination is highly unlikely at this facility. If contamination were present, it would be discovered prior to the transfer. Record will be maintained on site of inventories of sealed sources.

5. Premier Cardiovascular Specialists accepts full responsibility for the site. This facility is exempt from providing financial assistance for decommissioning because of the type of radioactive materials used (i.e. short-lived, unsealed sources in small quantities only). Routine radiation monitoring of the facility ensures that contamination will not be transferred during any subsequent change of ownership.

6. All parties involved with the transfer are aware and agree to the planned transfer of ownership.

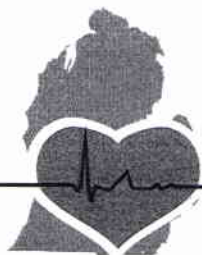

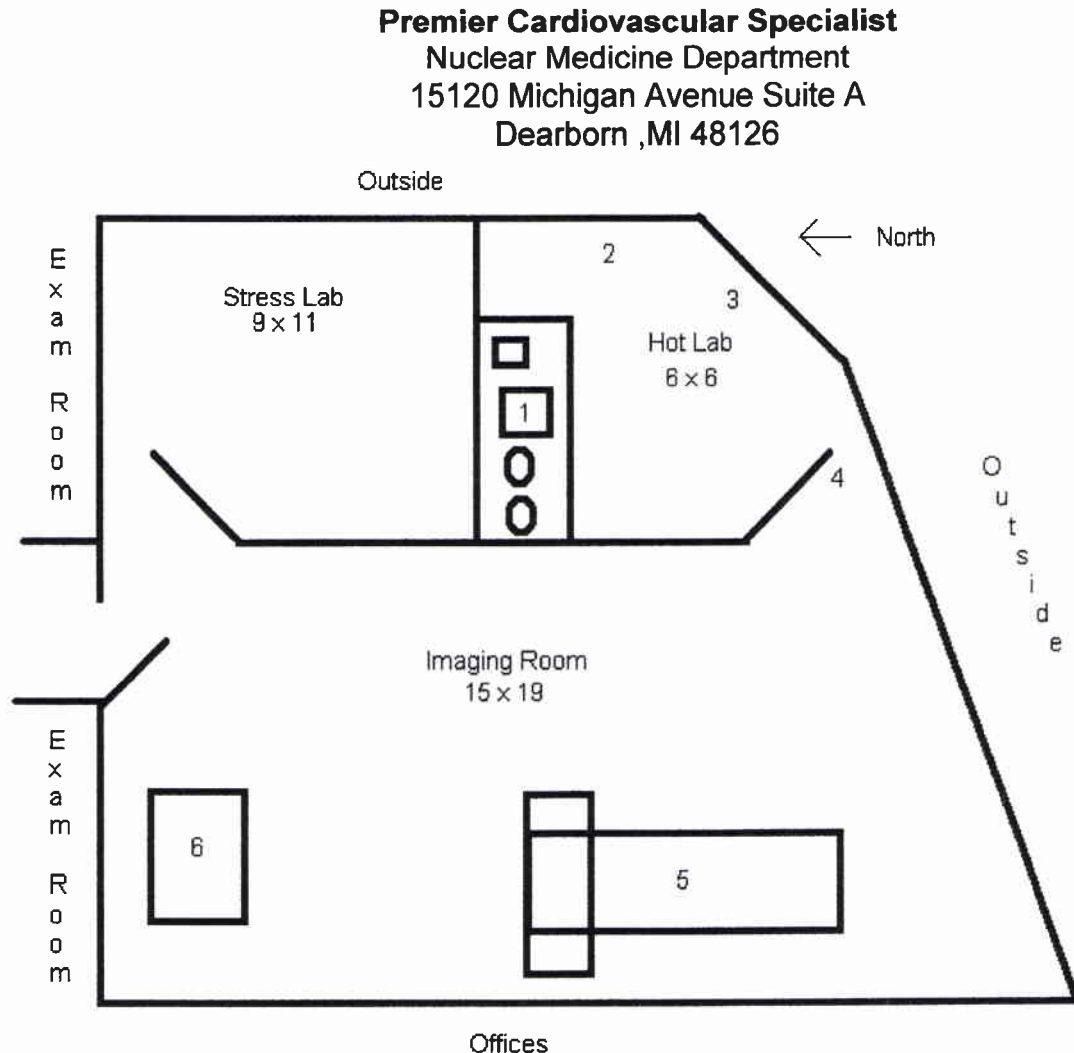
