NRC MEETING MARCH 31 IN ROCKVILLE, MD., ON PROPOSAL TO PRODUCE RADIOISOTOPES AT CLINTON NUCLEAR PLANT

Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff will conduct a public meeting at the agency headquarters in Rockville, Md., on Tuesday, March 31, to discuss a potential application from Exelon for the production of Cobalt-60 at the Clinton Nuclear Power Station.

Cobalt-60 is a radioactive material licensed by the NRC for applications such as commercial irradiators and cancer treatment. The meeting will provide Exelon an opportunity to outline its proposal to the agency. The public is invited to observe and will have an opportunity to address the staff before the meeting ends.

The NRC will hold the meeting from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. in Room E1B15 of the NRC's Executive Boulevard building at 6003 Executive Blvd. in Rockville. The NRC will close a portion of the meeting to discuss proprietary information. A teleconference line will also be available for members of the public to call in.
