Dear Mr. Smith:

This letter acknowledges the February 18, 2009, letter from Mr. Richard Stringer of your office, in response to our February 6, 2009, letter and enclosed Notice of Violation (NOV) that described one violation of NRC requirements. Your correspondence contends that the NOV was inaccurate with respect to the posting of radiation signs at the perimeter of the restricted area and the retraction of the radiography source to the shielded position. This letter also expressed an additional concern that there was an apparent conflict between two NRC inspection documents, wherein the NRC 591 Part 1 inspection record of February 5, 2009 indicated that there were no violations, and the February 6, 2009, letter included a violation.

When we received your letter, Ms. Marie Miller of my staff contacted Mr. Stringer by telephone on February 23, 2009. She informed him that we will review the additional information that he provided, discuss the information with the inspector, and provide our response to you in writing. We have begun our review, which includes a separate review by the NRC Office of Enforcement. We expect to fully respond to your concerns shortly.
