The purpose of this letter is to respond to the request for additional information (RAI) identified in the NRC e-mail correspondence to UniStar Nuclear, dated February 17, 2009 (Reference 1). This RAI addresses the Reliability Assurance Program, as discussed in Section 17.4 of the Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR), as submitted in Part 2 of the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant (CCNPP) Unit 3 Combined License Application (COLA), Revision 4. Reference 1 requested UniStar to respond to the RAI within 30 days.

UniStar requires additional time to complete the response to RAI 61, Questions 17.04-1 and 17.04-2. A response to this question will be provided to the NRC by April 30, 2009.
