Our letter of January 12, 2009, requested Enforcement Guidance/Discretion via development of an Enforcement Guidance Memorandum (EGM). Subsequent discussions with NRC staff have clarified for us the need for additional supporting information and detail in the request.

At this time we are continuing through our internal process to obtain final Honeywell management approval for implementation of the Integrated Plan we have developed as referred to in the letter.

At this time, we are requesting to withdraw our request submitted to you on January 12, 2009. Concurrent with obtaining final internal approval for our Integrated Plan, we will also evaluate the need to re-submit our request for Enforcement Guidance/Discretion, providing additional supporting information and sufficient detail to support the necessary NRC review process. Should we elect to re-submit this request, we will advise you at our earliest opportunity.
