FSAR, Section 13.2, "Training", incorporates by reference NEI 06-13A, Rev 0, "Template for an Industry Training Program Description." NEI 06-13A, Rev 1, which addresses a cold license training program, is now available. NEI 06-13A, Rev 1, has been approved by the NRC staff for use. FSAR, Section 13.2, includes information in addition to that specified in NEI 06-13A, Rev 0, to address the cold license process, but does not completely address the changes pertaining to the cold license training program that are in NEI 06-13A, Rev 1. Those portions of the cold license training program that are included in NEI 06-13A, Rev 1, but that are either only partially or not addressed in FSAR, Section 13.2, include eligibility requirements, licensed operator training and experience requirements, and crew experience requirements. Please provide a complete description of the cold license training program referencing NEI 06-13A, Rev 1, or justify an alternative.
