Subject: NRC license and financial assurance (NOTE: This will be used as the Documents Title in ADAMS)																										
Action Required: This license was spilt when Pennsylvania went Agreement on March 31, 2008. The license is written with possession limits commensurate with a laundry facility and it also authorizes use in a portable laundry unit. I called the licensee to see how they are using this license. The licensee has not used this license. The portable laundry unit is not in PA (probably in Barnwell, SC or in Morris, IL). The licensee was under the assumption that they needed an NRC license in case they performed licensed activities at a nuclear power plant. We discussed how Part 30 licenses are transferred to States/Commonwealths when the State/Commonwealth enters an Agreement with the NRC. The licensee stated that they will review their license and financial assurance to either: reduce the possession limits and therefore reduce or remove financial assurance (reflect license to be only a mobile laundry facility) or terminate the NRC license. The licensee was leaning towards the latter. I gave them 30 days to respond.
