

 - EAL A pre-determined, site specific, observable threshold for a plant Initiating Condition (IC) that places the plant in a given emergency classification level.
 - IC One of a predetermined subset of nuclear power plant conditions where either the potential exists for a radiological emergency, or such an emergency has occurred.


