Mr. Wendell:

Please provide the following information in support of a new license application so I can proceed with issuing the license.

1. 10 CFR 30.34, Terms and Conditions of Licenses, was revised to enhance the security requirements for portable gauges containing byproduct material. This revision became effective July 11, 2005. Revised 10 CFR 30.34 now requires that "each portable gauge licensee shall use a minimum of two independent physical controls that form tangible barriers to secure portable gauges from unauthorized removal, whenever portable gauges are not under the control and constant surveillance of the licensee" (i.e., when not in use). Guidance on these security procedures is provided in revised Appendix H of NUREG-1556, Volume 1, Rev. 1 (see attached APP H NUREG1556 Vol 1-errata).

Commit to the following language:

"We will implement and maintain the Operating, Emergency, and Security Procedures of Appendix H of NUREG-1556, Volume 1, Revision 1, and will provide copies of these procedures to all gauge users and at each job site."

2. Please fax the two negative leak test results to 817-860-8263 to my attention.
