- Joint Permit
  - Supplemental RAI response to USACE on former Thiokol
  - Phase I wetland mitigation plan provided to USACE/MDE
  - Joint agency consultation for Biological Assessment for Tiger Beetles scheduled for early April
- MHT provided formal response to the Phase I/II, Criteria of Effects, and Submerged Resources report 2/13/09
