Randy,

I hope you had a great vacation, but now it's back to work.

The attached table is the NRC's and Argonne's first cut at identifying the locations of, and required documents at reading rooms--which the NRC requests be set up by DTE--where NRC and its contractor staff can go and review Fermi 3 documents that, based on your feedback, I currently believe: (a) may not be released to us by DTE; or (b) will probably be released to us by DTE, but perhaps not as soon as we would need to see them. The reading rooms would not need to include any documents that are on the CD of publicly available ER references that you provided to us at the site audit. The table also identifies the NRC and contractor staff who Argonne and I believe would be using each of the reading rooms.

The NRC would like to get these reading rooms set up by DTE as soon as possible. I am currently assuming that we would need as many as three (3) reading rooms, located as near as possible to the

NRC and ERI (Rockville, MD), Argonne (Argonne, IL), and Ecology & Environment (Lancaster, NY); and that these reading rooms would be set up in the nearest Black & Veatch office to each of these locations (although that would be up to DTE). The locations of what I believe are the nearest Black & Veatch offices are shown in the footnotes to the attached table.

Please review the attachment and let me know if you have any questions, comments or concerns. I also need to know how soon you believe these reading rooms could be set up, how long they could remain open and available to us, and any stipulations on their use by the NRC and its contractors. Of course, the sooner these reading rooms can be set up and the longer they can remain open, the better.

I look forward to hearing back from you very soon on this matter.
