Notification to NRC of Extension of Security Submittal

UniStar Nuclear Energy has been preparing a security-related submittal for Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant Unit 3 (CCNPP Unit 3). The NEI 03-12 Revision 6 template will be used in accordance with NEI and NRC recommendations.

The NEI 03-12 Revision 6 (February) draft template was submitted to the NRC for review and endorsement in late February. All new plants were directed to use this template in the development of their respective submittals for submission by April 2, 2009.

On March 18, 2009 a revised draft of NEI 03-12 Revision 6 was submitted to the NRC by NEI for review and comments. Many applicants, including UniStar, were not informed of this second draft template until the New Plant Security Task Force (NPSTF) meeting at NEI on March 26, 2009. The members of NPSTF were informed of a revised NEI 03-12 Revision 6 (March) at that time. Several other applicants used the first NEI 03-12 Revision 6 (February) template to create their security submittals for submission on April 2, 2009, and we understand at least one applicant has already submitted its PSP using the NEI 03-12 Revision 6 (February) template to the NRC.

Every effort will be made to incorporate the revisions to the PSP that reflect the recent changes in the NEI template by UniStar. We will submit the revised PSP on or before April 10, 2009.
