As you are aware, the United States Government is obligated under the "Protocol Additional to the Agreement between the United States and the International Atomic Energy Agency for the Application of Safeguards in the United States" (the Additional Protocol) to provide to the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) an annual national declaration. This declaration will be developed from information received from the Departments of Commerce (DOC), Energy and Defense, and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). I am pleased to provide a copy of the NRC's United States Additional Protocol Vetting Record confirming the NRC licensees' information that will be consolidated by the DOC with other United States agency input for the United States declaration to the IAEA. The NRC previously provided an electronic version of the vetting record to the DOC/BIS on March 27, 2009.
