In speaking with Mr. Pessin & Ms. Swain, they had a couple of more questions for the licensee, TransCanada (License No. 21-29258-01, Docket No. 030-37442). These questions were as follows:


1. When did operations stop in using the gauges for their authorized use?
2. Since the gauges appear to remain on the pipelines, who owns the pipeline and is the pipeline still in use?

Depending on the licensee's response to the above questions, Mr. Pessin says that if TransCanada continues to own the pipeline and remain in control of the gauges, this is not "abandonment" per se. We can authorize the licensee for Possession Only (POL) license for 10 year expiration date. After a while, the gauges will either decay or the licensee will pull them up for disposal.

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ACTION REQUIRED

I sent Mr. Sal Delisi an email asking him the above questions. I am awaiting his response then I will forward his response to Mr. Pessin & Ms. Swain and they will direct me in the direction we should proceed.
