Chris,

Chuck Temus asked me to answer this question for you. Annually we make three to four shipments from MURR and one to two shipments from MIT. These are usually scheduled throughout the year. Based on the uncertainty of when the cask will be available, it is my intention to minimize as much risk as possible. This will be done by removing as much of the spent fuel as possible before the BMI Cask special permit expires on September 30, 2009. Based on this, my best estimate is that MURR and MIT will need to make a shipment in approximately December 2009 or January 2010 using the new BRR cask. The reactor facilities will need to modify their loading procedures and this may not be easily completed without the on-hands cask training that will be provided by AREVA Federal Services. Whatever NRC can do to assist us in ensuring the cask is available for these shipments would be much appreciated. Delays may result in the reactor facilities not being able to operate due to on site fuel limitations. If you need any additional information please contact me at 208-526-5876 or through e-mail.
