
Dear James:

Barnes Jewish St Peter's Hospital is currently approved for any byproduct material permitted by 10 CFR 35.300, as needed (not to exceed 1 curie of iodine-131). We would like to

1. Change the Authorized Use to include any diagnostic study or therapy procedure permitted by 10 CFR 35.300. Currently we are approved for iodine-131 oral administration of sodium iodide-131 in quantities less than or equal to 33 millicuries). The Areas of Use will remain the same.
2. Change the status of Dr. Lannis Elese Hall-Daniels, M.D. to be approved as an Authorized User for 10 CFR 35.300. Dr. Hall-Daniels is currently listed for such activity under NRC License 24-15159-01, amendment 58. Dr. Hall-Daniels qualifies as an experienced Authorized User under 10 CFR 35.57 b (2).
