Dear Mr. Wroblewski:

This concerns letter dated March 2, 2009, informing the commission of your use of NARM material. This also refers to my telephone conversation with you on March 25, 2009. Your letter informed the Commission that you possess and use Cobalt-57 in sealed form for instrument calibration. Since your license already authorizes use of Cobalt-57, there is no need to amend your NRC license. Further, in our telephone conversation, we discussed your marking of the letter with the words "Security Related Information Withhold from Public Disclosure Under 10 CFR 2.390". My review of the letter did not disclose any information that should be withheld under 10 CFR 2.390. Since you agreed that this letter should not have been marked to withhold from the public, we are returning your letter dated March 2, 2009 with this correspondence.

Since NARM material is now defined as byproduct material in 10 CFR 30.4, and cobalt-57 is already authorized by your NRC license, you are currently in compliance with NRC requirements and an amendment is not necessary, therefore, your request is voided.
