SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF NRC RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE

Dear Dr. Martin:

In a letter dated September 30, 2008, you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and indicated that you wished to terminate your NRC radioactive materials license. The NRC staff has reviewed the results of your final status survey. Based on this review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC radiological unrestricted use criteria.

Based on these conclusions, no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your facility is, therefore, suitable for unrestricted use and NRC license number 21-26519-01 is hereby terminated. An environmental assessment for this action was performed and noticed in the Federal Register Wednesday, March 25, 2009; Vol. 74, page 12911.
