Dear Dr. Deweese:

This concerns letter dated March 2, 2009, informing the commission of your use of NARM material. This also refers to my telephone conversation with William Breeden on March 27, 2009. During my phone with Mr. Breeden, he stated that your use of NARM material did not change your facilities as represented in your NRC license and did not change your radiation safety program in any way.

Since NARM material is now defined as byproduct material in 10 CFR 30.4, you are currently in compliance with NRC requirements and an amendment is not necessary, therefore, your request is voided. We do remind you that your use of NARM material is now subject to all NRC requirements in 10 CFR and your NRC license.
