Gentlemen:

As you know, on or about April 1, 1957, most of the work now being performed by the Atomic Energy Division of Sylvania Electric Products Inc. will be assigned to Sylvania-Corning Nuclear Corporation.

In order to perform the commercial portion of this work under the Civilian Application Program, we will require a source material license covering our Bayside and Hicksville locations. Sylvania's source material license No. C-3416 will not be required by the Parent Company after April 1, as indicated in Sylvania's letter to you of March 13, 1957. Would you please either transfer that license to Sylvania-Corning Nuclear Corporation or cancel it and issue a new license to us. We would like this application to include by reference the information contained in Sylvania's previous applications with regard to License No. C-3416. These applications were the letter of November 3, 1955 from Mr. W. E. Kingston to Mr. H. L. Price and the letters of March 6, 1956 and December 14, 1956 from Mr. J. McTavish to Mr. L. Johnson.

We hope that the modification or new license issued on the basis of this letter will become effective as of April 1, 1957.
