Dear Mr. Delaney:

We have an outstanding license authority number C-3700 for refined source material against which we wish to procure 100 pounds of normal uranium metal. For reasons of ease of fabrication it is desirable to procure this material in the form of reject plates from an A.E.C. facility.

I would like to have you confirm to us the telephone conversation we had on Friday, February 21st, regarding the availability of this material for civilian application. It is our understanding that current regulations disallow the sale of reject plates when the licensee wishes to procure this material for reasons of price and availability. We understand also that reject plates are available if a specific program requires their use and this information is made available to you.

We will appreciate confirmation of this information and enlargement upon it if possible.
