Assurances from Japan that the material will be subject to all of the terms and conditions of an agreement for cooperation are required. Your assistance in obtaining the necessary assurances will be appreciated.

Please note that the material is of Canadian and Japanese origin; converted in Canada; and enriched and re-converted in the U.S. It, thus, has Canadian and potentially Japanese obligations.
