PROGRAM SCOPE

Licensee is a manufacturer and distributor of nuclear gauges located in Plain City, Ohio. This licensee maintains an inventory of material to be used in the manufacturer and development of gauging devices.

Performance Observations

The inspector toured the facilities and interviewed staff members. Each appeared knowledgeable in radiation safety and isotope handling techniques. Emergency procedures in case of an accident involving radioactive material were demonstrated for the inspector. Proper posting of storage areas was observed. Independent surveys by the inspector did not detect any abnormal reading and were within the expected range.

During the course of the inspection, no abnormalities were noted.
