Dear Dr. De Motte:

This refers to your letter dated December 31, 2008, informing the Commission of your medical use of naturally occurring and accelerator-produced radioactive material (NARM). This also refers to my telephone conversation on April 8, 2009, with Jon Thoreson of your staff. Mr. Thoreson confirmed that NARM is being used only at the address stated above and in the rooms previously referenced in your license documents.

Since the medical use of unsealed NARM is now covered under 10 CFR 35.200 and the medical use of sealed NARM calibration/reference sources is authorized under 10 CFR 35.65, you are currently in compliance with NRC requirements and an amendment to your NRC license is not required.
