I am pleased to announce that on January 1, 1961, Sylvania-Corning Nuclear Corporation (SYLCO) became a division of Sylvania Electric Products Inc. Henceforth, it will operate as the SYLCOOR Division of Sylvania.

The change in SYLCOOR's status from a subsidiary corporation to a division came about only after a thorough study of the market for nuclear fuels and an analysis of that market's growth and the industry's technological development in the foreseeable future.


A primary reason for the change is the fact that other Sylvania divisions now will be able to make greater contributions to SYLCOOR in such areas as research and engineering, and materials studies and development. Furthermore, SYLCOOR will have the additional support of Sylvania's parent company, General Telephone & Electronics Corporation.

This support, when combined with the technical and production skills for which SYLCOOR -- the world's first nuclear fabrication organization -- has been widely known during the four years of its existence, will greatly augment our ability to satisfy your requirements for nuclear fuel elements.

We are looking forward to being able to work more closely and effectively with your technical and procurement personnel. Moreover, we shall welcome the opportunity to work with you early in the design phase of your nuclear fuel programs, because we believe that appreciable cost savings will result from earlier and closer collaboration.

The new SYLCOOR division will continue to maintain its headquarters and research laboratories at Bayside, N. Y., and its production plant at Hicksville. The SYLCOOR team is headed by Dr. Lee L. Davenport, a Sylvania Vice President, as General Manager; Dr. John L. Zambrow, Director of Engineering, at Bayside; and D. Boyd Metz, Manufacturing Manager, at Hicksville, in addition to myself.
