Status of Recommendations

Recommendation 3: Revise MD and Handbook 2.3 to include effective

management controls over headquarters staff use of agency

telecommunications services.

Agency Response Dated March 31, 2009:

Although progress has been made to submit the MD and Handbook 2.3 for final review and concurrence, higher priority work has impacted completion of this effort. The Office of Information Services (OIS) and the Computer Security Office recently awarded a task order contract to assist in the development, modernization, and organization of the revised Management Directive and its associated handbook in light of recent technology advancements in the industry and at the NRC. OIS expects to submit the Management Directive and its associated handbook to the Office of Administration by September 2009. Final concurrence and publishing is anticipated to take place in October 2009.

OIG Analysis:

The proposed corrective action addresses the intent of OIG's recommendation. This recommendation will be closed when OIG receives a final version of the MD and Handbook 2.3 to ensure it includes effective management controls over headquarters staff use of agency telecommunications services.
