Physical Attack: Initial Notification to NRC

- Licensee required to give accelerated notification (<15 min) to NRC
- Authentication Code verified by NRC
- Key details provided by caller/licensee
 - Facility
 - Classification of Emergency Class
 - Nature of attack (armed assault, vehicle bomb)
 - Attack status (Imminent, in-progress, repelled)



Physical Attack Notifications

Licensee does not maintain an open line HOO . HERO

Federal Agencies

- DHS National Operations Center
- FBI Strategic Information and Operations Center
- DHS National Infrastructure Coordination Center

Internal

- NSIR Office Director
- All RA/DRAs
- NRR, NMSS, FSME Office Director and Deputy

Internal

 HQ's and All Region's Information Assessment Teams

External

- Reactor and Fuel Cycle Facilities (Blast dial)
- Request increase security posture



Message to Licensees

- The NRC has received an authenticated report from [Name of facility] that they are under attack.
- [The HOO will provide the mode of the attack if known at the time].
- We request that you direct your site security and emergency preparedness personnel to immediately implement NRC Security Level V protective measures as described in your site security and emergency response procedures.
- These are response actions associated with a Severe Threat Condition as defined in the Homeland Security Advisory System.



Aircraft Threat Response Probable/Imminent

Headquarters Emergency Response Officer

- Defense Red Switch Telephone with Department of Defense
- Passes Track of Interest (TOI) information to Headquarters Operations Officer

Headquarters Operations Officer

- Conference Call
 - Licensees Control Rooms (100 mile radius)
 - First Imminent Security Treat Authority (ISTA)
 Manager

Role of ISTA

Ensure licensee carries out Imminent Aircraft Attack procedures, <u>if</u>
 <u>appropriate</u>
