In accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 30.36 and Condition 29 of NRC License Number 19-00915-03, I am submitting the U.S. Department of Agriculture's (USDA) revised plan to decommission the low-level radioactive waste burial site at the Agricultural Research Service's Beltsville Agricultural Research Center in Beltsville, Maryland. The USDA buried low-level radioactive waste at this site between 1949 and 1987 in accordance with Atomic Energy Commission and Nuclear Regulatory Commission regulations applicable at the time. This site is on the list of radioactive waste burial sites previously reported to you as requiring decommissioning. The enclosed plan was revised to reflect new information on waste streams and waste disposal costs developed from the Waste Characterization Survey conducted by Cabrera Services, Inc., (NRC License No. 06-30556-01).
