

COMMENTS OR SUGGESTIONS: (Continued)

THE EIS SHOULD INCLUDE ANY NEW ELECTRIC TRANSMISSION LINES THAT WOULD CONVEY POWER FROM THE PLANT - THE LOCATION & ALIGNMENT OF NEW POWERLINES SHOULD BE PART OF THE PLANT EXPANSION EIS AND NOT SEGMENTED OR STUDIED IN ISOLATION. THE 1980'S CULTURAL RESOURCES STUDY SHOULD BE AUGMENTED TO TAKE INTO ACCOUNT FINDINGS RELATED TO SITES IN THE MISSOURI R. FLOODPLAIN SINCE 1985. THE EIS SHOULD INCLUDE THE STUDY OF THE EFFECT OF THE WORK FORCE NEEDED TO BUILD THE FACILITY ON THE LOCAL ROAD AND SCHOOL SYSTEM. ROADS LEADING TO THE PLANT NEED IMPROVEMENTS (SHOULDERS/PAVEMENT STRIPS ON SR 94) TO REDUCE THE LIKELIHOOD OF CRASHES CAUSED BY INCREASED TRAFFIC DURING CONSTRUCTION - AND CONFLICT BETWEEN FARM EQUIPMENT AND MOTORISTS DURING THE PERIOD OF INCREASED ADT.
