Dear Ms. McIntosh:

Per our conversation of today, the New Jersey Department of the Treasury, Division of Property Management and Construction (DPMC) is responsible for building maintenance for thirty seven (37) locations in the Trenton and West Trenton, New Jersey area.

Several years ago all the DPMC Building Managers were asked to survey their buildings to determine the number and expiration dates of the tritium containing exit signs. DPMC then contracted with a licensed disposal company to properly dispose of these signs. While I do not have an exact number of exit signs, the actual number of signs that we did dispose of was no more than 150 signs.


Based on the Demand for information, I have again asked that the buildings be canvassed to determine the number, condition and locations of remaining signs.

Because of the vast number of buildings, turnovers in staff and management and the amount of time that has lapsed since the tritium containing exit signs were purchased, I will be unable to provide the information requested by Friday, March 20, 2009 as originally indicated.


By way of this letter, DPMC is requesting a 60 day extension for submittal of what information that can be provided.
